The draft should be prepared in consultation with respective RO</p> <p>Five (5) hard copies of the final report should be presented</p> <p>Report should be presented within THREE (3) weeks of sample collection.</p>
4	30	Annexure 2 pt. 7	Field Sampling (parameters to be analysed)	Should the bidder possess NABL certification for all the parameters mentioned.	<p>It is mandatory that ALL the parameters should be tested / analysed in laboratories having NABL certification for the respective parameters. In case the Service Provider's NABL certification does not cover particular parameter/s, the Service Provider has to seek written permission from MPCB to get the sample analysed from a External Laboratory that is certified for the Parameter/s. In such case it will be Service Providers responsibility to identify and verify the certification of such External laboratory and give documentary evidence of such External laboratory along with valid certification and capability statement. MPCB at its sole discretion may accept such request. The costs towards analysis of samples from such an external laboratory will have to be borne by the Service Provider and they will be solely responsible for the quality / veracity of the results. The Service Provider will also indemnify MPCB against any issues arising out of such work</p>
